## SIGNS of CHRONIC PAIN in CATS

*Check the box if you have seen any of these symptoms in your cat*

- Absence of grooming
- Reluctant to move
- Abnormal gait
- Difficulty to jump
- Licking a particular body region
- Withdraw/hiding
- Lameness
- Avoiding bright areas
- Appetite decrease
- Lameness
- Less rubbing toward people
- Abnormal gait
- Groaning
- Eyes closed
- Shifting of weight
- Reaction to palpitation
- Lower head posture
- Blepharospasm (involuntary forcible blinking)
- Change in form of feeding behaviour
- Playing less
- Growling
- Temperament
- Hunched up posture
- Straining to urinate
- Tail flitching
